



# Training in Athens

On 14, 15 and 16 March 2023 the project held its first training in Athens, Greece, organised by 4-Elements. It was attended by 16 participants between staff and young trainers. The aim of this training was to train the young trainers in the use of the Training Methodology, the third result of the project. This guide provides young people with assistance on how to support older people to get started in the use of new technologies.



# PILOT TESTING OF THE TRAINING METHODOLOGY

After the training in Athens, the young trainers have put into practice the new knowledge and skills acquired in this experience through pilot testing of the Training Methodology in their countries.

During the several piloting sessions held in the five countries of the consortium, the young trainers worked together with the seniors who attended, helping them to better understand the use of their electronic devices by carrying out the activities proposed in the methodology, as well as solving any doubts they might have.

In all countries the seniors were grateful to have been able to benefit from the help and expertise of the young people. ¡Activities like these show that communication between generations is the way forward when it comes to technology education!







# Mentoring Methodology

As part of the fourth result of the project partners have developed a Mentoring Methodology which aims to help young people during the process of accompanying an older person to become more creative on the internet.

The activities and methods proposed in this Mentoring Methodology were presented to the young trainers in the second project training in Malaga.



## 2nd Training and 4th TPM in Málaga

On 26th, 27th and 28th September 2023 the second training of the project, organised by DEFOIN, took place in Malaga, Spain. Also on the last day, 28th September, the partners held the fourth transnational meeting of the project.

During the training, the young mentors had the opportunity to carry out some of the activities proposed in the Mentoring Methodology and to experience first-hand how the mentoring process is carried out, especially focused on working with seniors and the use of new technologies. In the upcoming months, this Mentoring Methodology will be tested through different pilot testing experiences that will be conducted in all the countries of the partnership.
